

Perry Sesquicentennial Pie Baking Contest

Contest Rules and Information

Pies:

1. This contest is intended for amateur bakers only. Professional bakers or those who earn a portion of their livelihood from baking are asked not enter the contest.
2. Each dessert pie must be made from scratch, you may not use pie filling or a pre-made store-bought crust.
3. Pies that need special handling, refrigeration or heating elements are not allowed. (i.e., dairy or custard based pies)
4. We recommend that pies are baked in disposable pans only, as pans will not be returned. Each pie must include a cover.
5. Following judging all pies will be sliced and offered for a free will donation with proceeds to benefit the Perry Community Building fund and prize money for contest winners.

Entry:

1. Pie must be entered in the name of the person who made it.
2. Each entry must be submitted in only one category.
3. Categories include: nut, fruit, other and 18 & under
4. Multiple pie entries per person are allowed.
5. Fill out an entry form for each pie you enter in the contest.
6. Contestants are asked to preregister before the event by filing out the contest form available on the PerryMo150.org website. Forms may be submitted to Jan Garner by mail at the address provided below.

Judging:

1. Pie MUST be checked in by 12:30 a.m. on contest day (8/6/16) at the St. Williams Altar Society booth at the Bill Trower Memorial Park.
2. Pies will be scored on Appearance, Crust, Filling and Overall Flavor/Taste.
3. Winners will be announced at 2:00 p.m. at the main stage.
